Beyond the Critics: Finding Strength in the Struggle

Readers,

“It is not the critic who counts; not the man who points out how the strong man stumbles, or where the doer of deeds could have done them better. These lines have stuck with me since I first read them at 18, and even five years later, they still remind me every time. They’re not just words—they’re a mantra that carries me through thick and thin, through ups and downs, and through those relentless moments of doubt.

We all face moments that shake us to the core—moments that make us question our strength. For me, it was multiple attempts at my CA Inter exams. The weight of expectations, the shadow of doubt, and the pressure—sometimes from friends, family, even strangers—felt relentless. It’s easy in those moments to focus on the criticism and forget the effort you’re putting in. But that’s exactly why Roosevelt’s words matter: it’s not the critic who counts, but the person in the arena—striving, failing, and trying again. Every failed attempt isn’t a defeat; it’s proof that you dared, that you persisted, that you showed up. That’s where growth and resilience are born.

I’ve spent nights staring at my books, questioning if all the effort was worth it, doubting myself more than anyone else ever could. Every failed attempt felt like the world quietly telling me I wasn’t enough. But slowly, I realized: it’s not about the voices pointing out your mistakes—it’s about showing up, day after day, even when failure seems inevitable. Every setback became a quiet declaration of courage; every doubt a reminder that I was still in the arena. And in that arena, even when I stumbled, I felt alive with purpose, shaping myself in ways no criticism could touch.

In the end, it’s not the critics, the doubts, or the pressures that define us—it’s the courage to keep showing up. Every attempt, every setback, every uncertain moment is proof that we dared. Success isn’t just in passing or winning; it’s in stepping into the arena, giving your best, and daring greatly. That’s where true strength, resilience, and growth are born.

AI in Corporate Governance & The Board Room

Artificial Intelligence has evolved from a technical tool to a major governance and leadership priority. Boards and corporate professionals must now treat AI as an issue of accountability, transparency, and legal compliance — not merely technology management. The India AI Impact Summit 2026 emphasized human-centric, responsible, and accountable AI under the pillars of *People, Planet, and Progress*, and demonstrated unprecedented economic attention to AI, with major corporate investments signaling the need for board-level oversight.

Key Themes

1. AI as a Governance Imperative

- Boards remain accountable for AI-assisted decisions under the *Companies Act, 2013*.
- AI introduces risks around explainability, data use, and regulatory compliance.
- Governance professionals, especially Company Secretaries, must translate technical AI issues into auditable, policy-based frameworks.

2. Statutory and Standard Frameworks

- Companies Act, 2013: Reinforces directors' fiduciary responsibilities when AI affects outcomes.
- Secretarial Standards (SS-1 & SS-2): Require detailed documentation and traceability in AI-related board decisions.
- Regulators (SEBI, MCA): Moving toward formal AI governance expectations.

3. Professional Deliverables Governance officers can add measurable value through:

- Board-approved AI Policy.
- AI Inventory/Master Register tracking system ownership and impact.
- AI Dashboards for board reporting.
- Incident Response Templates and Vendor Contract Checklists.

AI in Corporate Governance & The Board Room (Continued.....)

4. Board-approved AI Policy – Core Elements

- Clear purpose, scope, and definitions.
- Defined governance structure (Board, Risk Committee, AI Oversight Group).
- Impact-based approval thresholds and human-in-the-loop controls.
- Robust documentation, vendor governance, and procurement controls.

5. AI Inventory, Records, and Minutes

- Maintain AI system registers as formal internal control ledgers.
- Minutes and board papers must record model details, validation metrics, and board rationale to meet SS-1/SS-2 standards.

6. Contracts & Procurement

- Include AI-specific clauses: data governance, IP ownership, explainability, liability, and audit rights.

7. Incident and Escalation Protocols

- Include AI-specific triggers for board escalation, regulatory notification, forensics, and remediation tracking.

8. Training & Operational Roadmap

- Governance professionals must gain AI literacy and establish relationships with data and audit teams.
- Roadmap:
 - 30 days: Baseline inventory & board brief.
 - 90 days: Draft policy, classify systems, review contracts.
 - 180 days: Implement dashboards, audits, incident testing.

9. Ethics, Trust, and Transparency

- Embed fairness, privacy, and human oversight principles in policy.
- Publish audit summaries for high-impact AI systems to build trust.

10. Global Practices

- Companies like Microsoft, IBM, Google, JPMorgan Chase, and Infosys have embedded responsible AI frameworks, emphasizing accountability, explainability, and ethical control.

Main Takeaway

AI governance is now a core boardroom responsibility. Boards and governance professionals must ensure that AI-driven decisions are transparent, auditable, and ethically managed through structured frameworks, policies, and accountability mechanisms. Effective AI governance aligns innovation with trust, enabling sustainable growth while meeting statutory and regulatory expectations.
